The Pilot

The Company's core product H-Net™ has been deployed for a pilot in Managua, Nicaragua with Union Fenosa (UF). The demonstration is the first phase of a rollout program with an agreement that was signed in November 2009. The eight unit meter system demonstration deployed within the field with two units at the meter lab at UF for verification and functionality totaling 10-meters have been successfully installed on January 25th 2010. The H-Net system required adoption of new protocol interfaces, a new cellular provider for communication and software modifications to accommodate Managua, Nicaragua's infrastructure. Testing and experiments were conducted over the course of several months for full system integration. Due to these modifications which should be considered as an adaptation of the Managua infrastructure, the official starting date of the H-Net pilot began on February 22nd 2010. The pilot is thus far a complete success. The Company learned by experience that Electrical Brownouts, blackouts, internet and communication interrupts occur much more frequently than had been anticipated which required on the fly software changes within the H-Net BaseStation and backend support systems. We know now that these types of interrupts are common throughout Latin America.

The fact that we have overcome these issues in and of itself is a hallmark example of the Company's technical skills and knowhow proving its willingness to adapt to adverse conditions, which will be known as the stepping stone for future H-Net projects in South America at large.

The Contract

The H-Net Meter System pilot with UF in Managua, Nicaragua is the first phase of a rollout consisting of a successful 60 day demonstration, which had been signed in November of 2009. The demonstration then after becomes a purchase order for the pilot equipment. The pilot agreement rolls into a full contract of which terms have been substantially agreed upon and are now with UF and ConectiSys' attorneys to finalize legalities and make ready for signing and future purchase orders. Again, the official pilot starting date began on February 22nd 2010.

Due to the Easter Holiday UF executives have been out of the office from March 30th through April 6th which has delayed the progress to signing significantly. The Company anticipates the release of a purchase order from UF by the end of April to early May 2010.

The Companies CEO Robert Spigno returned to the United States on March 29th 2010 after a long stay resulting in a successful pilot and demonstration in Nicaragua.

In addition, time was spent setting the necessary structure by training new personnel in support of daily operations for the H-Net network for customer service made possible through our new distributor in Latin America assisted by Luca Spigno during the month of February. Robert Spigno stated, "I am extremely pleased with the progress we have made with Union Fenosa in Managua. Based on this, the Company anticipates new opportunities not only in Latin America, but Columbia and greater South America."

Manufacturing/ New Demonstration

ConectiSys' CEO will be traveling to Costa Rica. A manufacturer has been selected in Costa Rica. Mr. Spigno will be arriving in Costa Rica on Monday April 19th 2010. Mr. Spigno will also meet with officials of the publicly held utility in Costa Rica to propose a pilot similar to the Managua project, and further, the Company is looking at the potential in Panama for the same and anticipates arriving in Panama by May 17th 2010 to speak with corporate officials in an effort to expand the program within UF.
