The Purchase Order

The company is in the process of fulfilling its recent purchase order from Gas Natural Fenosa.

ConectiSys Corporation has been working closely with Camtronics, a Costa Rica based manufacturer to fulfill the purchase order of 500 units. Camtronics and ConectiSys have also been incorporating additional features to the H-Net BaseStation for customization throughout Central and South America. The company feels very strong about its relationship with our manufacturer. Camtronics is highly qualified to carry out current and future orders in South America.

Schedule

The Company's CEO Robert Spigno will be preparing to travel to Costa Rica on Monday July 19th to evaluate manufacturing samples, production test procedures and quality control.

Mr. Spigno will then travel to Nicaragua to meet with Gas Natural Fenosa utility operations management team and our installation and network maintenance subcontractor Datatex for continuous training of field network support. The support capabilities of the selected subcontractor Datatex cover territory throughout Central America.

The Datatex team is currently Union Fenosa's (now Gas Natural Fenosa's) blackout management team as well as equipment supplier and installer. Datatex is also an independent solar energy provider and network administration facilities management group.

Marketing

The Company has determined that it will maintain a sales team and presence in Managua by agreement with Discover Energy a wind farm developer. Discover Energy is a well networked group that will help ConectiSys Corporation navigate and obtain new contracts in Central and South America.

Mr. Spigno is aggressively seeking additional pilots within Central and South America openly discussing future relationships between parties with full intent to expand operations throughout. The company is also pursuing opportunities in California which show promise.

Our small staff has been extremely occupied with logistics in the field. The new purchase order has required much of the company's resource and attention.
